Eligibility issues – checklist

To avoid being deemed ineligible by national/regional Funding Organisations, all the Beneficiary Partners, are encouraged to check carefully the coverage and requirements of relevant Funding Organisations before starting the proposal.

Eligibility information is available in the call text **Annex C. National/regional requirements including contact point information**. (Relevant sections are marked in bold below.)

Common eligibility issues for Beneficiary Partners in earlier calls:

- ➤ Topic not covered/not relevant for the Funding Organisation

 Check Eligible Call Modules for the relevant Funding Organisation.
- ➤ TRL too low/limited innovation

 Check Eligible types of RDI and TRL for the relevant Funding Organisation.
- ➤ TRL too high

 Check Eligible types of RDI and TRL for the relevant Funding Organisation.
- Budget issues
 Check Maximum funding per awarded project/per partner and Eligible costs for the relevant Funding Organisation.
- ➤ Insufficient involvement of companies/industry- Check above all Eligible types of organisations and Additional eligibility criteria of the relevant Funding organisations in the consortium and make sure all partners have an active role in the project.

- Specific national requests not followed/application/declaration/documentation missing
 Check Submission of proposal/documentation at national/regional level and send all requested information and documentation to your Funding Organisation well before the national/regional deadline (may differ from the CETPartnership's submission deadline).
- ➤ Beneficiary Partner not eligible to apply

 Check Eligible types of organisations and Eligible types of RDI and TRL for the relevant Funding Organisation.

Remember that additional information may be found in Annex C of the Call text, under **Additional eligibility criteria**, **Information available at** and **Other**. In cases of uncertaintycontact your local funding organisation.
